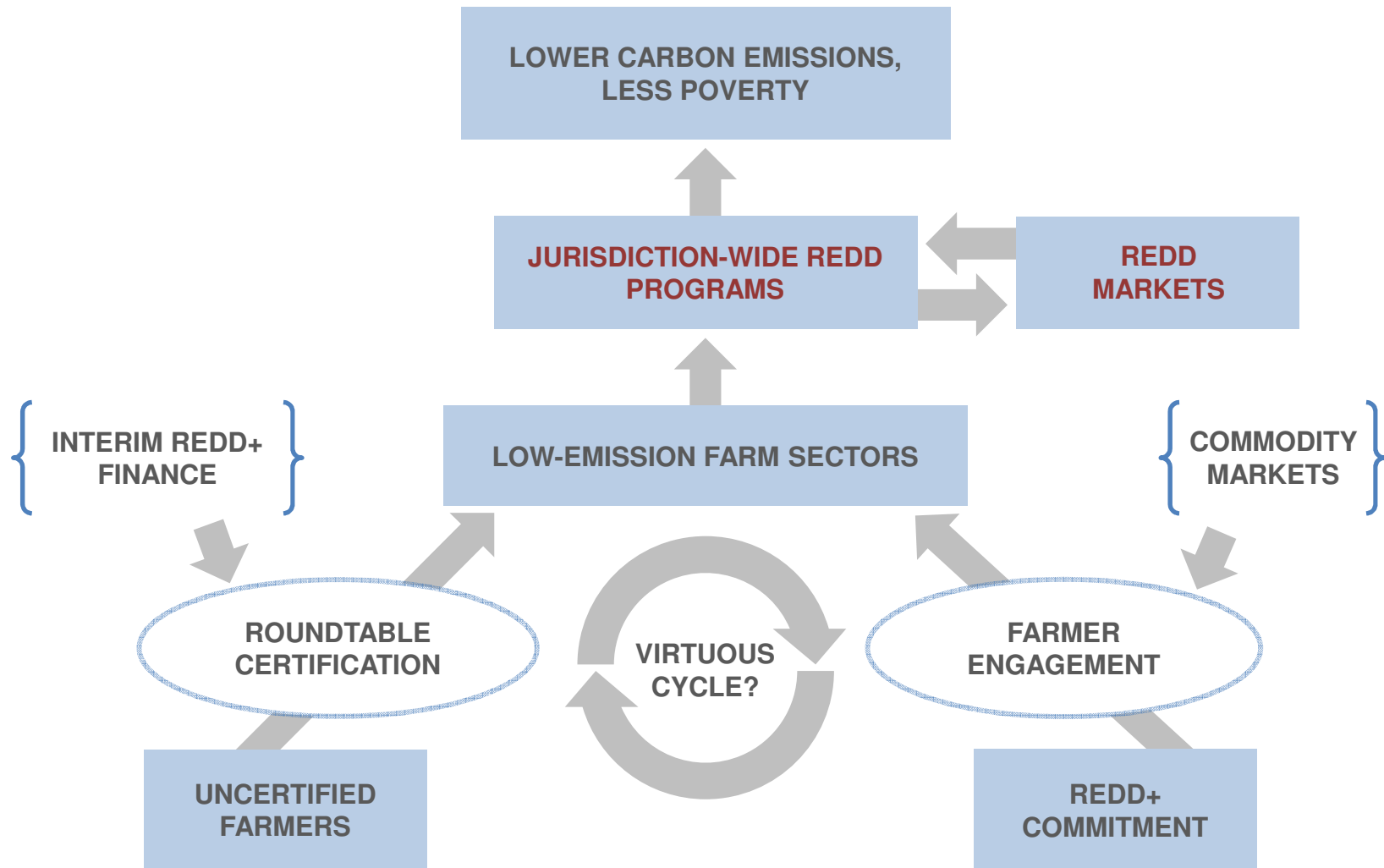
# **A Solution: Low-Emission Rural Development as Foundation for Broader Agenda?**

- *Conserve Biodiversity*

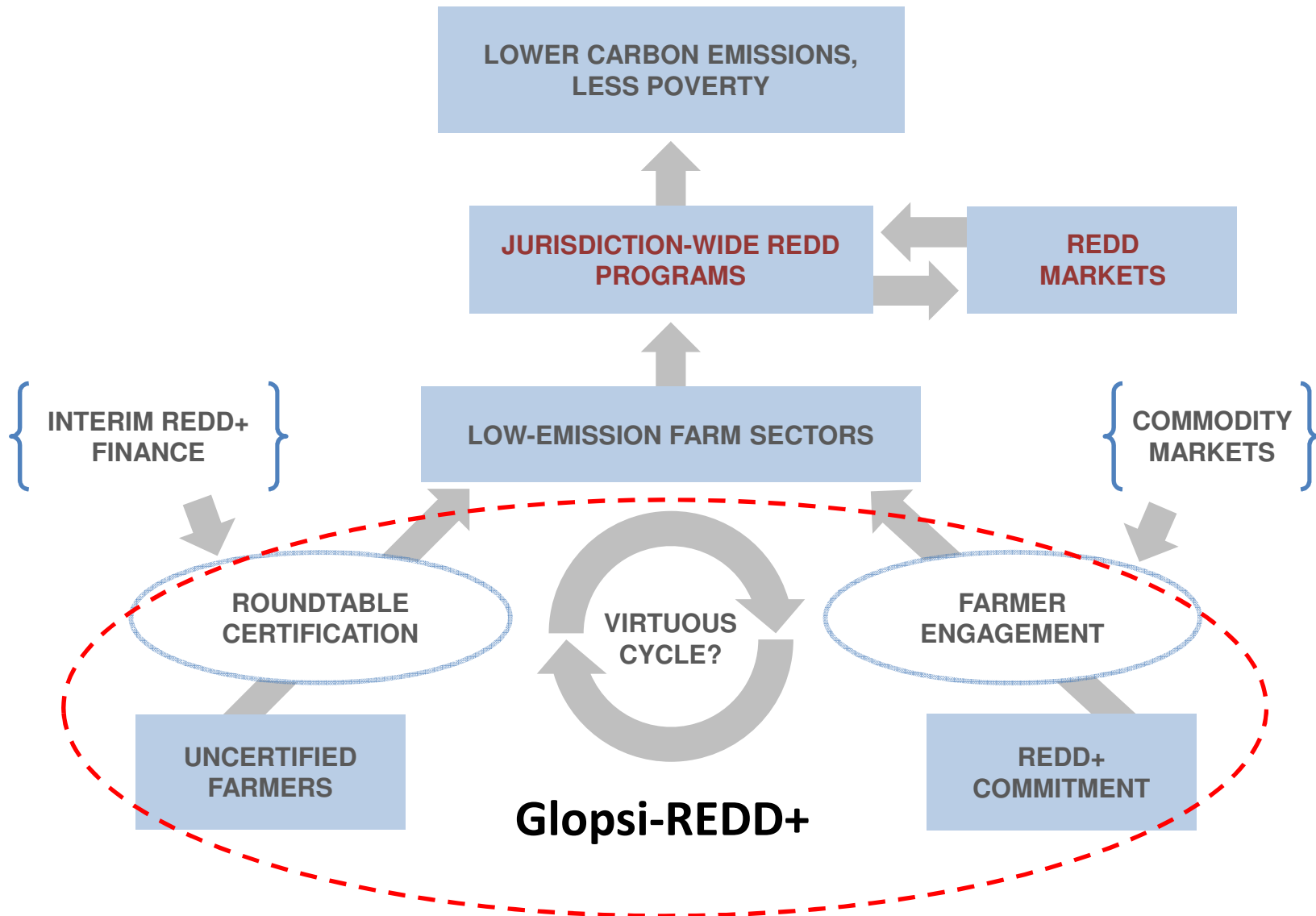
